GUIDELINES FOR PARENTS

- Parents / guardians will strictly abide by and follow the rules and regulations of the school issued from time to time relating their studies, examination, conduct and discipline.
- In the event the child is withdrawn from the school, all the fees due must be paid and the fees paid to the school will not be refunded.
- Late reporting from leave/school attendance will be seriously reviewed. Unsatisfactory progress in work may be assumed of discontinuation from the roll.
- The parents/Guardians are requested to check their ward's diary, home work and class work regularly and also see that they do the work assigned to them. They must be careful in respect of their attendance.
- Any instructions/remarks made in the diary should be seen and countersigned by the parents/guardians. If there is any complaint, it must be mentioned in teacher-parents communication page of the diary.
- Parents/Guardians are requested to deposit school fee within the time limit (i.e : by 18th of every month). Late payment means spending extra money and inconvenience to them and the school.

GUIDELINES FOR STUDENTS

- All the students must possess school diary, text books, note books, stationery etc.
- Students are advised not to bring valuable articles to the school. The school will not be responsible for any loss.
- Application for leave must be submitted one day in advance. It should be counter signed by the parent/guardian.
- Students must come in school uniform.
- Students are not allowed to leave the school during working hours unless the parents/guardians whose names are on the admission forms and the school diary come in person.
- School identity cards must be with the students on all working days.
- Students should be regular in attendance.
- Any damage to the school property by the student will have to be borne by the respective parents/guardians.
- The school reserves the right to take stern action even to strike off the names of the students from the school rolls who are found guilty of misconduct.



SESSION

The academic session begins from the 1st of April to 31st of March next year.

ADMISSION OPEN for Nursery to Std. VIII & XI

1. **ADMISSION FORM:** Can be availed of from the first week of November every year. Admission forms can be collected from the school office for the classes Nursery to Std- VIII & Std- XI between 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon.

2. **DOCUMENTS REQUIRED:**

For Nursery to UKG:

Birth Certificate: From the municipality/ Notified Area Committee/ Office of the Registrar of Birth or Certificate of Baptism (if the child is Christian).

Caste Certificate to be submitted for SC/ST/OBC students.

EWS Certificate to be submitted for the economically weaker section (if applicable).

A Xerox copy of the **Birth Certificate** should be attached to the Admission Form for school records. The original certificate should be brought along for verification at the time of admission.

For Std-1 onwards:

- Original Transfer Certificate from the previous school.
- Blood group report (Photocopy)
- Aadhar Card (Photocopy)
- Progress Report Card. (Photocopy)
- Original Conduct/Character Certificate.
- Date of Birth Certificate (Photocopy)
- EWS Certificate (Photocopy), if applicable
- Caste Certificate for ST/SC/OBC category students. (Photocopy)

Note: At the time of admission, produce original certificates for verification.

For nursery admission, the child must be 3 years old as on March 31.

Important

Obtaining a form does not guarantee admission.

25% of the total seats at the entry level are reserved for the BPL category students as per the RTE norms ; provided valid documents.

Scholarship Facilities

At Srinath Public School, we believe scholarships empower minds and fuel dreams. Our program supports talented students, regardless of circumstances.

Eligibility Criteria:

1. **100% Tuition Fee Exemption (Std. XI)**
 - 95% or more in previous exams
 - Continuation in Std. XII: 90% or more in Std. XI final exam.
2. **50% Tuition Fee Exemption (Std. XI)**
 - 90-94% in previous exams
 - Continuation in Std. XII: 85% or more in Std. XI final exam.

Note: Full fee payment required if scholarship conditions aren't met.



ATTENDANCE :

As per the CBSE norms 75% attendance is mandatory. If your child is unable to attend his/her classes due to some health issues or an emergency, prior information has to be given to the class teacher/office authorities by the parents.

Expectations and Etiquettes



Do's

1. Attend school regularly and be punctual.
2. Maintain proper discipline and behavior in school.
3. Wear the prescribed uniform and maintain personal hygiene.
4. Be respectful to teachers, staff, and fellow students.
5. Complete homework and assignments on time.
6. Participate actively in co-curricular activities.
7. Keep the school environment clean and tidy.
8. Follow all school rules and regulations.
9. Ensure regular communication with teachers and parents.
10. Use digital tools and the internet responsibly for learning.
11. Use the school diary as a means of communication with the class teacher and check the diary for homework and the teacher's remarks, if any.
12. Sign the test copies/papers as and when sent home.
13. See that your ward has all the textbooks, items of stationery, craft materials, etc. right at the beginning of the session.
14. Ensure that all the books and notebooks are covered with brown paper.
15. Ensure that your ward comes to school in proper uniform with polished shoes, trimmed hair, and clean nails without any cosmetics/chemicals.
16. Send the children regularly and punctually to the school. No absence will be permitted without a leave application, and latecomers will not be allowed to sit in the class.
17. Both the parents must attend the Parent Teacher Meet.



Don'ts

1. Don't use mobile phones or gadgets in class without permission.
2. Don't engage in bullying or harassment of any kind.
3. Don't damage school property or tamper with any equipment.
4. Don't use unfair means during examinations.
5. Don't bring prohibited items like sharp objects or harmful substances to school.
6. Don't disrespect or misbehave with teachers, staff, or classmates.
7. Don't loiter in corridors or restricted areas during school hours.
8. Don't engage in any form of misconduct that can harm the reputation of the school.
9. Don't spread false information or rumors.
10. Don't engage in cyberbullying or misuse of social media.
11. Don't send the child in case of an infectious disease, and a medical certificate should be furnished from a medical authority at the time of rejoining school after illness.
12. Don't walk into the classrooms or meet the teacher in the classroom. Please see the subject teachers with prior appointment of the class teacher.
13. Don't visit the teachers at their residence.
14. Don't send money or valuable articles to the students. The school takes no responsibility if they are lost.
15. Don't pay even an amount less than ₹1/- without a printed receipt or official information.
16. Don't provide any electronic device, i.e., mobile, calculator, pager, or motorcycle, to your ward.

ABSENCE

- One who remains absent must submit an application duly countersigned by the parents on the day of resuming the classes.
- No leave is granted except on medical grounds.
- Repeated absence without leave or unexplained absence for more than 10 working days renders the student liable to have his name struck off the rolls, re-admission may be granted only on payment of a fresh admission fees.
- It is compulsory for the students to complete 80% of their attendance in the year to make them eligible to sit for their final examination. But in classes IX, X, XI and XII the students must have 75% attendance to be eligible to take the examination.
- Absence due to sickness must be supported by a medical certificate. The students attending school after suffering from an infectious disease such as measles, chicken pox, cholera, mumps, whooping cough etc. must produce a fitness certificate from a registered doctor.

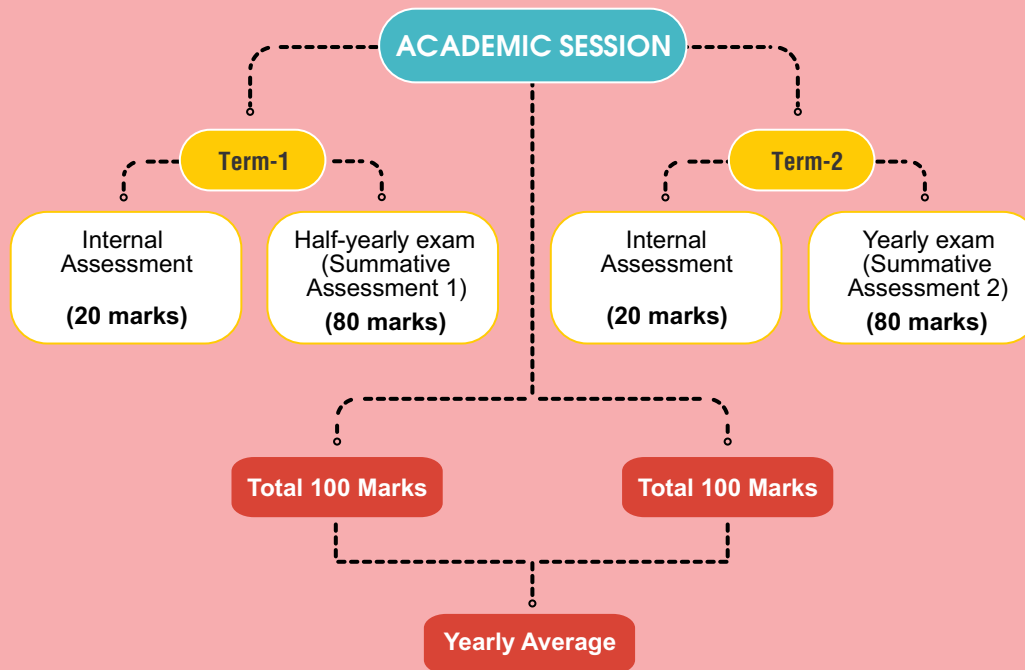
